Tadley Arts Festival

Saturday 17th and Sunday 18th October

at St Paul's Church

The largest Arts Festival around Tadley is back for 2026! This is one of CTAT's bigger events. In 2024 over 2,000 people visited the exhibition or took part in events which this year take place at St Paul's Church and Hall.

Here's a rundown of what's happening.

All weekend: Art and Crafts

Opening times for the Art Exhibition are:

Saturday 17th October from 10am to 5pm

Sunday 18th October from 12pm to 4pm.

Come along and view or buy art work by local artisans. There will be food and music throughout and the chance to see artists at work. You can also get involved in creating art yourselves.

We want to display work from all ages and all abilities. Art work can be dropped off at St Paul's between 6pm and 8pm on Thursday 15th October or between 10am and 4pm on Friday 16th October. It can be collected, if not sold, from 5pm on Sunday 18th October.

All weekend: Get involved with the Arts Festival Community Art Project

Throughout the weekend everyone is invited to contribute to a giant mural called 'Our Tadley'. This is a chance to tell us what Tadley means to you!

We hope the giant mural will then go on tour around Tadley in churches, shops, and public venues. Everyone is welcome to contribute.

All weekend: See artists at work

Throughout the weekend artists will be working. Pop along at different times to see how poetry, stained glass, or fused glass are made.

All weekend: Live Music

This year we have a full programme of musicians, poets and performers both in the church and in the Arts Café (hall). Come along and enjoy the best of classical and contemporary music performed specially for you.

Saturday 17th at 4.30pm: Community of Musicians perform The Blessing

To close proceedings on Saturday 17th, musicians from around our community, including most of our CTAT churches, will perform a very special version of 'The Blessing'. This is something that will have taken weeks of rehearsals and promises to be a wonderful performance.

Saturday 17th at 7.30pm: Open Mic/Musical Showcase Evening at URC Tadley

After the close of the exhibition on Saturday you are invited to move across the road to the URC and either enjoy or take part in the talents of local musicians. It promises to be a great evening of entertainment. Any money raised will be sent to the Adonai Centre in Uganda.

Sunday 18th at 10am: CTAT Arts Festival Service at St Paul's

Join together for a wonderful Sunday morning service surrounded by art! There will be a special VIP early viewing with refreshments from 11am, for anyone at the service, and before the festival opens at midday to the public.
