“We will remember them”

During November we remember the suffering caused by wars and conflicts past and present and we support charities that help veterans and their families. In WW1 alone over 1 million British and Commonwealth troops died and over 2 million were wounded between 1914 & 1918. Total casualties worldwide have been estimated at 20 million. The Tadley war memorial lists 31 local men who died, St Luke's church lists another 6, and a further 10 are listed in St. Mary's from Heath End. This month we pause and remember them.

As well as our usual events, this month Steve will be leading the Basingstoke Armistice Day and Remembrance Day services, and our churches will be represented at the Tadley Town Christmas lights switch-on. Our churches also lead the acts of remembrance in Tadley, Baughurst, Pamber Heath and Silchester – all the details are in this newsletter. This month we also have new first Sunday services being developed across all 3 parishes. As always there is certainly a lot to pray for and take part in this month. You and your friends and family are always welcome to come to any event in any of our benefice churches.

Churches Together Around Tadley have this year agreed to join forces to have a toy collection this Christmas instead of shoeboxes. We are asking for new toys for any age child which can be dropped off at any of our churches.

The toy collection is run by the Salvation Army and collections can take place right up until the week of Christmas as the toys are distributed locally by our churches to families who really need them, so there are no overheads other than the donated toys. If you normally pack a shoebox, this option is still available, but these will need to be delivered to St. Paul's during the first two weeks of November to ensure they reach their destinations. Toys can be delivered right up until Christmas week. A special Toy collection will take place at St. Mary's, Silchester on 3rd Dec and at St. Paul's Messy Church on 10th Dec.
